Welcome Back!

Monday night is Curriculum Night for grades 1-8: Parents and students are welcome. Everyone should bring all their supplies and leave them in their desks/lockers so there is less to bring on the first day of school (Wednesday). Stop in the office for your family folder if you have not done so yet. Also, pencil cases, laddie pencils and canvas book bags will be available for sale. Please follow the schedule below:

6:00-6:20pm- grades 7 & 8 will gather in the gym for a group meeting with the teachers. Parents and students will then be invited to go to the classrooms until 7:30pm.

6:30-7:00pm – grades 5 & 6 will gather in the gym for a group meeting with the teachers. Parents and students will then be invited to go to the classrooms until 8:00pm. ** Please do not try to enter the gym until the junior high has gone upstairs.

7:00-8:00pm – grades 1-4 will have three 20-minute sessions in the classrooms (7:00-7:20, 7:20-7:40, 7:40-8:00). All sessions will be the same, please do not plan on staying behind for a private meeting with the teacher. If you need to schedule a conference, send an e-mail to set one up at a time where you can have the attention and privacy you and your child deserve. The first 20-minute session tends to be very crowded because everyone is excited to be back. It was suggested that if you can (you only have one or two kids) – attend the second or third session – it's usually less crowded/hectic. Thanks, Mrs. Hamer, for the wise suggestion!

Where do we line up on the first day?

Attached is the map of the lines for the first day. Since so many parents park cars and stand with their children, the parking lot will be crowded on day one. Please be patient, kind, and safe. Usually day begins the normal drop off routine.
